DiBianca says she has always loved mystery books and hopes her debut novel appeals to readers who enjoy the genre. "People with analytical minds probably tend more to mystery writing since it consists of creating a puzzle that needs to be solved. The desire to understand, to search out the truth and solve the problem is a part of the human condition. If we can figure it out, we can deal with it."

"The Watch on the Fencepost" is a mystery novel whose protagonist, Kathryn Frasier, discovers a gold watch on a fencepost. She senses that it was deliberately left for her to find, and when she identifies the owner, a dark family secret is uncovered and the deaths of her parents no longer seem accidental. Kathryn follows a trail of cryptic clues on the hunt for the possible killer, only to become a target herself.

DiBianca says her background in computer science was the springboard for crafting the plot of "The Watch on the Fencepost."


